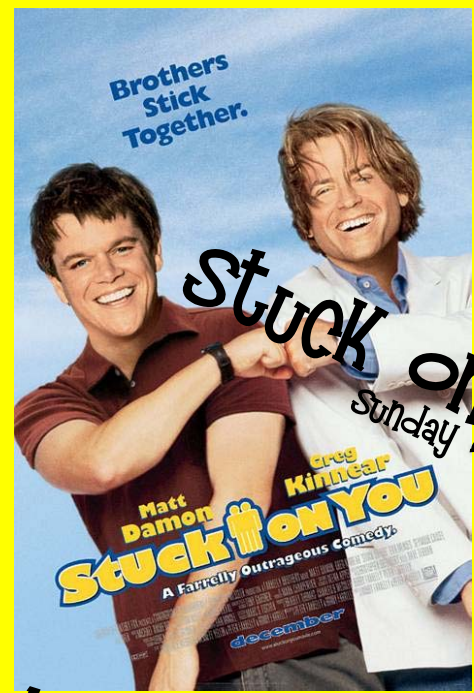

This is a three-day festival of comedy in American media that features films, television, and stand-up that satirize and parody stereotypes of disability.

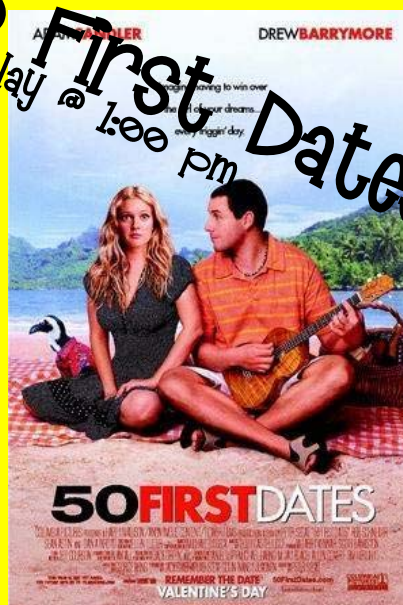
